Gift Aid is a fantastic way to make your donation go even further.

The charity can claim an extra 25% from the taxman, meaning every £100 can be turned into £125!

This can be claimed on all donations made by individuals who pay UK Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax equal to or above the amount of tax we can reclaim on the donation. Please ensure the full name and home address, including postcode, are completed on your sponsorship forms and the "Gift Aid" box is ticked.

For our overseas challenges we can't claim Gift Aid on sponsorship from:

- Your husband, wife, civil partner or linear relative (e.g. your son, daughter, parents or grandparents)
- Any linear relative of your husband, wife or civil partner
- A company under your control or under the control of any of the above
