You can purchase any of these resources on websites such as Amazon, and art and craft stores online such as The Works, The Range and Hobbycraft.

- <u>Set of ink pads, multi coloured</u> for when creating your prints on your tree(using a variety of colours, ie rainbow tones, colours of choice :)
- A4 or A3 paper, pref art paper such as cartridge etc.
- Wet wipes (as this activity can get messy!) when changing colours for finger printing etc.
- Pencils for drawing the tree shape etc first before applying pen
- · Fine liner pens for writing family names and any illustration parts.
- Colouring pens/ pencils to colour your tree, sky etc, these can be normal colouring pencils, felts etc, whatever you may have at home or can purchase.
- · Additional choice of a frame that you would like to present well once completed.
- Note to do this preferably as a family activity as it is more fun! And also ask an adult if you need any assistance with drawing the tree shape etc and also the little birds.
- Important remember to clean fingers after using each colour stamp so colours do not mix when printing each time when using different colours!
- Note you can use a mix of colours, ie rainbow shades if you would like to stick to the current themes, or you could do individual colours of choice for each family member in the household to personalise or for however many people you are creating your tree with!
