

# Sensory and Music Story: Bonfire Night!!

This 'Sensory and Music Story' has been designed to be used either by a parent / carer and child at home, or as part of a Music Therapy session, led by a Music Therapist via Zoom.

### Hints and tips:

- Gather all the props before you start. If you do not have everything exactly, don't worry any improvisations are fine!
- Familiarise yourself with the story and what happens where. Think how you will use the props and songs to make the most impact and sense to the child you are working with.
- It is natural to feel self-conscious about singing, but there are no 'X Factor' style judgements being made about your voice! If you can sing with more confidence and volume then that will make more of an impact – it does not matter if you are out of tune (or think you are!).
- If you have other small instruments at home, you may want to use these with the child you are working with during the songs.
- Read the story slowly, repeating the part of the story that has just been read when feeling the relevant props. If the child is responsive to a certain part or you know from previous experience that they will enjoy something then stay longer with that prop or song.

### **Props:**

cat or dog (real or otherwise!) in a 'bed' / blanket scarf and hat Candle (and matches – where safe!) Bubble wrap Gloves A skewer or similar to be a 'sparkler' Bucket / container of water to put 'sparkler' in Blanket Torch / sensory lights Musical instruments Bells / chimes







## The Story:

It was a lovely autumn day – where shall we go today? It is the week of Bonfire Night – so we should go in search of a fireworks display!!

### **Sing:** We're all Going to the Fireworks today

We were excited to go and see the massive bonfire and some fireworks – but why did we do that? The rhyme said...

Remember, remember the fifth of November, Gunpowder treason and plot. We see no reason Why gunpowder treason Should ever be forgot!

Well ok! We would just go out and enjoy the fireworks!

Before we went out, we needed to make that our pets were somewhere safe – they often like don't like the loud bangs!

Feel: Put cat or dog (real or otherwise!) in a 'bed' / blanket

We got ready to go out into in the cold November evening, putting our scarves and hats on.

### Feel: Put scarf and hat on

When we got to the big Fireworks Display, they were just about to light the bonfire. We counted down... 5,4,3,2,1.... And it was alight!

Feel: Light a candle (after the countdown!) Sing: Bonfire's Burning

We could hear the fire burning and crackling!







**Feel / listen:** Scrunch some bubble wrap to sound like the crackling of the fire!

Then we went in search of some sparklers! First of all we had to put on our gloves...

### Feel: Put on some gloves

Then we were given a sparkler! When they were lit we all wrote our names in the air with them!

**Feel:** Write your name in the air with the 'sparkler' (a skewer or similar)

When the sparklers came to the end we had to dispose of them safely – we put them into a bucket of water.

Feel: Put your 'sparkler' into a bucket of water

It was nearly time for the big fireworks display! Some of the fireworks have been put to music...

Sing: The Firework Song
